~ *Artist Tribute* to Denise Morris Curt, the Connecticut Limner, for her amazing work of 48 years on the nationally recognized spring and autumn. Meet the Artists and Artisans shows on the Milford Green. Her shows have been fine cultural additions to the character of charming Milford and shall be

missed.

The NY Times sponsored all four of the MTA&A shows in 2010. In 2009, Denise's Milford show was again rated one of the top 100 Best Fine Art Shows in the U.S. (only show in Connecticut awarded) and one of the top 10 (#8) fine art shows in the Northeast by Sunshine Artist, America's premier art show and festival magazine. Rated Best 100 events for the millennium in North America, awarded by the American Bus Association.

Curt states, "I have been most fortunate to meet amazing and creative artists with imagination, endless talent, tremendous fortitude, who withstood all manner of weather conditions at the outdoor shows. They proved their strength of purpose by creating works of beauty and wonder for the loyal collectors, inspired children, and devotees of my carefully selected group of exhibitors. My passion for "unique, one-of-a-kind art" has brought me searching the world over to discover both ancient and contemporary marvels, which would be a good fit for my juried-only shows."

Ms. Curt's works are in collections throughout Europe, South America, and nearly every state in the U.S. Noted collectors of her work include Leonard Bernstein, J. Paul Getty, Paul Mellon, Blanca Ossorio Patino, Vincent Price, Billy Rose, J. D. Salinger, and Pamela J. Hoiles. Frequently interviewed on television as the only American Limner using the jewel dust technique, she retains the wisdom of early art practices to create lasting pieces in her Ange Bower studio that appears as though it comes from a fairy tale and the precious dust of emeralds, mica and tiger's eye are stored for the alchemist's practice.
